

ORDINANCE NO. 504

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SOUTH PRAIRIE, PIERCE COUNTY,  
WASHINGTON REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 454 AND CHANGING THE OFFICIAL  
NEWSPAPER OF RECORD FROM THE COUNTRY GAZETTE TO THE ENUMCLAW  
COURIER HERALD FOR PUBLICATION OF LEGAL NOTICES.

Whereas, Ordinance No. 454 established the Official Newspaper of Record as the Country Gazette, and

Whereas, The Country Gazette ceased publication on March 25, 2008, and

Whereas, the Town needs to change the official newspaper of the Town for the purposes of publication, and

Whereas, pursuant to RCW 35.23.352 the City Clerk has contacted the Courier Herald and the Tacoma News Tribune (TNT) to get bids for what the two papers would charge to publish the Town's legal notices; and

Whereas, the TNT quoted a price that was more than three times as high per column inch as that quoted by the Courier Herald, making the Courier Herald the low bidder.

Now, therefore, the Town Council of the Town of South Prairie, Pierce County, Washington do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 454 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


Section 2: The Enumclaw Courier Herald replaces the Country Gazette as the legal paper of record for the Town of South Prairie.

Section 3: If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions shall remain in force and affect.

Section 4: The Town Clerk/Treasurer is directed to publish this ordinance in the Enumclaw Courier Herald.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.


