

ORDINANCE NO. 512

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SOUTH PRAIRIE, PIERCE COUNTY,
WASHINGTON AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 488 RELATING TO PARKING
RESTRICTIONS ON NW WASHINGTON STREET.

Whereas, Ordinance No. 488 restricted parking on the north side of NW Washington Street to residents of the street and their guests, and provided that unauthorized vehicles would be towed at the owners' expense; and

Whereas, in this era of economic downturn, the Town lacks resources to devote to enforcement of the no-parking zone; and


Whereas, the Town Council wishes to encourage citizens and visitors not to park on the north side of NW Washington Street unless they are a resident or guest.

Now therefore the Town Council of the Town of South Prairie, Pierce County, Washington do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 488 is amended to remove Section 3, which states, "Any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance, without a permit, may be impounded without notice at the owner's expense."

Section 2: Sections 1, 2, and 4 of Ordinance No. 488 remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.




